

LEGISLATIVE BUSINESS AWAITING POSSIBLE ACTION OF THE 1967 LEGISLATURE*INTRODUCTION

The 78th Wisconsin Legislature convened on January 11, 1967, and recessed on July 28, 1967; reconvened on October 17, 1967, in accordance with Senate Joint Resolution 86 and recessed on December 16, 1967, until January 6, 1969, unless reconvened by petition of a majority of the members prior to such date, in accordance with Senate Joint Resolution 97.

When the Legislature recessed on December 16, 1967, the Senate had been in actual session on 100 days and the Assembly on 104 days. A total of 1,700 bills (S-577; A-1123) had been introduced; 215 joint resolutions (S-99; A-116); and 61 resolutions (S-33; A-28).

The 1967 Legislature passed 373 bills (S-149; A-224); of these, 355 were signed into law by the Governor (including 5 with partial vetoes) and 18 were vetoed (thus far, 2 vetoes have been sustained by the Legislature; on the other 16 legislative action remains pending). The Legislature also passed 95 joint resolutions (S-48; A-47) and adopted 50 one-house resolutions (S-28; A-22).

The 1967 Legislature rejected 145 bills (S-46; A-99), 19 joint resolutions (S-10; A-9) and 1 one-house resolution (S-0; A-1).

Legislative action remained incomplete on 1,182 bills (S-382; A-800), 101 joint resolutions (S-41; A-60) and 10 one-house resolutions (S-5; A-5).
