

A GUIDE TO THE WISCONSIN BLUE BOOK1853 to 1962

## INTRODUCTION

The Wisconsin Blue Book is generally considered the finest source of information on Wisconsin, on the government of the state and the various departments into which this government is organized, on the Wisconsin people and the economic and political activities, on Wisconsin historical facts, and other items normally found in a state manual.

Yet, there are, and have been in the several editions of the Wisconsin Blue Book since 1853, many other things which are not immediately associated with materials generally found in state manuals. The 1962 edition, for instance, contains a main article of more than 100 pages on "Wisconsin and the Civil War;" other editions have contained such exotic information as "How to Detect Counterfeit Money" (1866 edition, page 11), the national platform of the People's Party (editions from 1897 to 1911), or "Paul Bunyan and the Blue Ox" (1931 edition, pages 113-127).

The present study is designed as a guide to utilize this great store of information which, because the Wisconsin Blue Book has been so widely distributed to schools and to public libraries throughout its history, is available in many of the libraries in Wisconsin. It is available -- but without a guide it is frequently impossible to find an individual item although the librarian may well remember that she has seen it in the Wisconsin Blue Book (if only she could remember in which edition!).

## HISTORY OF THE WISCONSIN BLUE BOOK

On January 14, 1853, an unnumbered Assembly resolution was adopted by the Wisconsin Legislature calling for the printing of "750 copies of the rules of this house ... together with such statistical matter as ... will be useful to the assembly." The Assembly charged its Speaker with the direction of the publication's preparation. By the term of the resolution, 100 copies of the edition were to be deposited "with the librarian, by him to be distributed to the next assembly," and the remainder of the edition was to be distributed to the Legislature of 1853 "in the usual manner" (1853 A.Jour., p. 31). From this humble beginning, the Wisconsin Blue Book has since developed into a publication of approximately 800 pages issued regularly in biennial editions of 45,500 copies.

(1) Authorization for the publication of the Blue Book.

The edition of 1853 was specifically authorized by the resolution cited above. No further editions were prepared during the 1854-1858 period. The Blue Book was issued annually from 1859 to 1866, each edition being specifically authorized by resolution or joint resolution. In 1866, the authorization for the preparation, printing, and distribution of the Blue Book was put on a statutory basis (1866 Laws, Ch. 20). Annual editions of the Blue Book continued until 1882.

(2) The Blue Book as a biennial publication.

In 1881 the Wisconsin electorate approved a constitutional amendment providing for biennial sessions of the legislature. Biennial publication of the Blue Book, at that time still a manual and reference book for the use of the legislature, began with the edition of 1883; however, the corresponding statutory text remained unchanged until 1889 (Laws, Ch. 421). Publication of the Blue Book was changed from the odd- to the even-numbered years in 1939 (Laws, Ch. 36). Since that time, and beginning with the edition of 1940 which followed that of 1937, the Blue Book has been published biennially to become available in the summer of each even-numbered year.

(3) Adoption of the "Blue Book" title.

From the beginning the publication has been bound in blue cloth but, although the legislative resolutions of 1860 and 1861 already had casually called for the preparation, in each case, of "an edition of the Blue Book," this wording was not immediately adopted as the publication's title.

The 1853 Blue Book had been called "Manual for the Use of the Assembly." Those of 1859 to 1861 carried the similar title "Manual of the Customs, Precedents, and Forms in use in the Assembly of the State of Wisconsin." The editions from 1862 to 1878 were each called "The Legislative Manual of the State of Wisconsin."

The term "Blue Book" finally became part of the statutory language with the enactment of the 1878 Revised Statutes (Laws 1878 Spec.Sess., Ch. 2). Beginning with the edition of 1879 and ending with that of 1911, the publication was officially cited as "The Blue Book of the State of Wisconsin." Since the edition of 1913 the title has been "The Wisconsin Blue Book."

(4) The editors of the Blue Book.

The first edition of the Blue Book (1853) was prepared under the direction of the Speaker of the Assembly. Later editions were compiled by the Assembly's Chief clerk (e.g. 1860, A.Res. 9), or the Chief Clerks of both houses of the Legislature (e.g. 1862, Sen.Jt. Res. 5). When the preparation of the Blue Book was put on a statutory basis in 1866, the Secretary of State was appointed as its editor (1866 Laws, Ch. 20).

In 1901, the preparation of the Blue Book was transferred to the Commissioner of the Bureau of Labor and Industrial Statistics (1901 Laws, Ch. 405). Then, when that bureau came under the direction of the Industrial Commission in 1913, the function of editing the Blue Book devolved upon the Industrial Commission (1913 Laws, Ch. 771, s. 11).

The state Printing Board became the editor of the Blue Book in 1917 (Laws, Ch. 549). Since 1929, it has been the duty of the Legislative Reference Library to "compile, index, prepare, and deliver to the printing board biennially copy for" the Blue Book (1929 Laws, Ch. 194).

(5) Number of copies per edition.

Only 750 copies were printed of the Blue Book's first edition in 1853; of the second edition appearing in 1859, 500 copies. From 1860 to 1866, each of the resolutions which authorized renewed editions of the Blue Book called for an edition of 1,000 copies. In 1866 (Laws, Ch. 20), this became the statutory number. The edition was raised to 2,500 (1878 Laws, Ch. 248), to 4,000 (1879 Laws, Ch. 141), then to 4,500 copies (1880 Laws, Ch. 123).

In 1889 legislation passed to supplement the statutory edition by an additional 17,000 copies for that year, and to print 25,000 copies of each future Blue Book edition (1889 Laws, Ch. 421). 1891 legislation (Ch. 333) to cut back the size of the edition to 8,000 copies affected only the edition of 1893. In 1895 (Ch. 211) the legislature authorized the printing of 17,000 copies of the Blue Book for that year, and again set the general norm at 25,000 copies.

The specification as to the number of Blue Book copies per edition was omitted in the 1898 Statutes (Sec. 121). According to a Revisor's note in the 1897 Revision Bill (Bill 33, S.), "the increase in the number of school districts, libraries, etc., will call for a larger distribution from time to time. The number can be approximately determined by the secretary of state (then editor of the Blue Book), with whom the responsibility can safely be vested."

An upper limit of 45,000 copies per edition was established by Chap. 657, Laws of 1911. Reduced to 37,000 copies in 1913 (Ch. 771), the numerical limitation was again omitted by Chap. 549, Laws 1917. Since that time, estimated demand, and the size of the appropriation for that purpose, have determined the number of copies of the biennial Blue Book editions. For the recent editions of 1958 and 1960, the number printed has been 45,500.

(6) The development of the Blue Book's content.

The Blue Book had its origin as a manual and reference book for the use of the legislature. Beginning with its very first edition in 1853, the publication contained the rules of the Senate and Assembly, "together with such statistical matter as... will be useful." Much of the material which has been printed as part of the Blue Book was selected because of statutory directives. Thus, beginning in 1862, Jefferson's Manual, seating charts of the Senate and Assembly, and pictures of the Capitol were regularly contained in the Blue Book. 1866 legislation (Ch. 20) added to this the requirements that the Blue Book contain lists of Senators and Assemblymen and of legislative employes, and the texts of the constitutions of Wisconsin and of the United States.

But, of far greater influence in the shaping of the Blue Book's character than the statutory enumerations, have been the general directives first encountered in 1853 "together with such statistical matter as ... will be useful," and "of the same general style (as heretofore published)." The latter was added in 1861 (A.Res. 2). It is by this general directive that the Blue Book contains such matters as a list of the post offices in Wisconsin (since 1853), election statistics (since 1860) and population statistics (since 1862). The manual of 1862 was the first to contain an extended

article on a topic of general interest ("The Southern Rebellion."). Biographies of the state officers and the members of the legislature first appeared in the manual of 1870; descriptions of the state institutions in 1872. Each succeeding edition added a little new material, but hardly any topic which had been dealt with in prior editions was omitted from those succeeding, with the result that the editions of 1907 and 1909 reached 1,222 and 1,191 pages, respectively, not counting maps and other inserts.

In 1899, the legislature started publishing a Legislative Directory in addition to the Blue Book; in 1907, it added a Legislative Handbook. As a result, the rules of the Senate and the Assembly, and Jefferson's Manual, were omitted in 1911 (Ch. 657). At the same time, the length of the Blue Book was limited to approximately 800 pages. That section of the Blue Book devoted to the Federal Government and its offices in Wisconsin was discontinued with the edition of 1958 (it had been a regular feature since 1862), and the text of the U. S. Constitution last appeared in the Blue Book of 1950.

From 1907 until 1921, county clerks reported directly to the Blue Book editors on election statistics and other information necessary for the compilation of the book. The practice has been discontinued, but the material formerly collected on this basis remains part of the Blue Book.

The Blue Book changed its character from a legislative manual to a general reference book by the legislation of 1911 (Ch. 657). In line with this change, the publication's editors were by statute instructed to "consult freely with the state superintendent (of public instruction) and the director of the state historical society" when making the selection of matter to be included in the Blue Book. Since 1929 (Ch. 194), when the Legislative Reference Library was appointed as Blue Book editor, it has been the purpose of the publication to be "useful for civics classes in schools."

#### RECIPIENTS OF FREE BLUE BOOK COPIES, 1853 to 1960, AND NUMBER ALLOCATED TO EACH

The tables which follow will show in detail how the statutory free distribution of Blue Books has developed through legislation from 1853 to 1959. In order to make the survey more useful, it has been attempted to group the information by subject heading, rather than by the "and then" method of a recital of historical growth.

Had the latter method been chosen, then it would have been sufficient to cite each chapter of the session laws which has affected the statutory free distribution of Blue Books, in the chronological order since 1853. However, by latest count based on the 1959 Wisconsin Statutes, Blue Books are specifically allocated to about 50 different public officers, departments, or agencies.

In each of these classifications changes have occurred many times. In addition, several classifications which appeared at one time in the statutory provisions concerning the free distribution of Blue Books (since 1853) are no longer part of the statutes in their edition of 1959. In part, this is due to changes in the departmental structure of the state government of Wisconsin but, it is also due

in part to changes in the philosophy underlying the free distribution of state publications.

The organization of the table following corresponds closely to the classifications used in the 1959 edition of the Wisconsin Statutes, Section 35.84, Column "C". Some changes had to be made in the sequence of the various subdivisions, and in the specific classifications used, to facilitate an organization of the data as much as possible within the context of their historical development. As an example of this, we cite the case of the Blue Book allocation to newspapers. In the 1959 Wisconsin Statutes, Sec. 35.84 allocates in Line 78, Column C, 1 copy of the Blue Book to each newspaper, "as listed in Blue Book." The allocation is so listed in connection with a number of other allocations made to "Educational Institutions." However, in its historical context we see that originally, copies of the Blue Book were allocated "to each reporter for a daily newspaper in regular attendance at the session" of the legislature (1877 Laws, JR 2). Thus, in the tables which follow the allocation of Blue Books to newspapers appears together with the allocations made to the "Legislature."

The subheadings used for the table appear in the following sequence: (1) State Officers, (2) Legislature, (3) Judiciary (Wisconsin court system) and State (law) Library, (4) State Agencies and Societies, (5) Federal Government, (6a) Local Government and (6b) Libraries (other than those listed under State Government, Judiciary, or Educational Institutions), and (7) Educational Institutions (including affiliated administrative boards and libraries).

First incorporated into Sec. 121 of the 1878 Revised Statutes, the statutory free distribution of Wisconsin Blue Books has successively been part of the following statute sections: 1911 Stats., Sec. 20.84 (12); 1917 Stats., Sec. 35.84 (14); and 1959 Stats., Sec. 35.84, Column C.

And every such direction to distribute to public libraries or to each public library without other limitation means and includes the state library, the

Milwaukee county law library (added by 1931 Laws, Ch. 406), the university law library, the Milwaukee law library association, and the Oshkosh law library, the state historical society, the libraries of the University of Wisconsin, of the legislative reference department (added by 1913 Laws, Ch. 771, s. 31), of the state colleges (1911-45 "state normal schools," 1945 to 1953 "state teachers colleges"), of all chartered colleges and academies having three hundred or more volumes each, and of all other public libraries within the state having one thousand or more volumes, each."

## THE ORGANIZATION OF THIS GUIDE.

Early in the preparation of the study it was decided to use the form of a "guide", rather than that of an "index." The difference is that the guide quickly summarizes the several editions in which information on a particular subject has appeared, without stating specific page numbers for individual editions. This saves a great deal of space in the preparation of this bulletin; at the same time, and since each edition has had its own index (some better than others), it is felt that the method chosen will not seriously impede the usefulness of the study.

Page numbers are given for major articles, or items of special interest which could not readily be identified from the index to the particular edition. The guide also contains an author index to signed articles because frequently a librarian will remember that a particular author wrote something on a specific subject which appeared in the Wisconsin Blue Book; reference to the author index will help to quickly identify the specific edition.

Every index is limited by the number of subject headings used. Its usefulness is increased by the use of additional cross-references, the listing of particular items under several headings, etc. To index the 65 editions of the Wisconsin Blue Book in this fashion would have resulted in a volume of prohibitive size. Instead, the guide has been organized by topic, with the majority of the materials listed in one place only. Several of the broad topical headings have then been further subdivided internally to make them more manageable; the subdivision most frequently used in conjunction with a topical heading is that of "statistics."
