(b) A numbered and undocumented boat is a boat 16 feet long or longer and under 5 net tons. In general, this would be your larger outboards, outboard cruisers, and most inboards up to 60 feet. This category applies only to those boats on Federal waters and does not include any boat on waters entirely within the boundary of a given state. (c) Unnumbered boats are those boats between the rowboat and pram class and the numbered class. (d) Documented boats are those vessels of 5 net tons or over owned by citizens of the U.S. which may be documented as yachts if used exclusively for pleasure. The 5-net-ton figure is derived by figuring the cubic capacity of the vessel and excluding spaces used for machinery, the Master, etc. In general, boats of 65 feet or over would be documented. (u) Unassigned, 240.
